




Centennial, Colorado January


Like any forecast of severe weather, we had to see for ourselves. Roque and Neal digging out the sidewalks the day after.








Bridgeport Center Elevator Lights









New LED lighting kit was installed in the elevator cabs to make them brighter. This change allows the engineer to change the bulbs as needed.





















Signature Exchange Welcomes New Employee Laura Linda Cervera
